

#### 409.5 Water and Sewage

All multi-family developments shall be served with off-site sewage facilities and water supplies (as defined in the Township Subdivision Ordinance). Developers proposing the use of either community sub-surface sewage disposal or treatment involving a stream discharge shall have first investigated and determined that land application of effluent is not feasible. Effluent disposal areas shall be subject to the setback requirements applicable to other multi-family buildings and structures. However, a field used for drip irrigation of treated effluent may be setback a minimum of 10 feet from a lot line where the adjacent lots are both within the DD district. Developments using sub-surface or land application sewage disposal shall identify on the development plan reserve areas suitable for similar sewage disposal to be used in the case of the malfunction of the primary system. \_
